

DEPOT AT SEVINGTON RAIL FACILITY

Project Detail

The Depot at Sevington, near Ashford, is a Network Rail high output operating base. Its strategic location allows for the importation of construction aggregates through receiving ballast trains to serve the local market. It is therefore a prime location for where larger railway track maintenance schemes are loaded and provided with materials to undertake ongoing maintenance of the local rail network.

Suttle Projects were tasked with building kingpost walls against which track ballast aggregate could be stored, therefore increasing the storage capacity. Around 248 kingpost piles were installed at the site in total.

For this project we used:

-  Casagrande B125 piling rig
-  Movax side grip on 34 tonne and 14 tonne excavators

The works also included an adaptation and fabrication of some steel sections for installation in a sensitive area where services were present.
